PROPS

We will be providing you with a set of props to use
throughout the film. Included in the set:

- A small bag of confetti
- A newspaper
- A party hat
- A pair of rubber gloves

We'll also provide a mini water pistol to each group attending

each of your props!

DRESS CODE

We highly encourage fancy dress, and will be awarding a
prize for the best outfit! However, you should dress in
whatever makes YOU feel comfortable.



AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION

Although this is an audience participation event, we want everyone to have a wonderful time and feel comfortable throughout! Our wonderful cast who are leading the audience participation will at various times come down the aisles and may interact with members of the audience. If you do not want to be interacted with, simply make an “x” with your arms in front of you and we’ll know you’d like to opt out of any interactions.

CALLOUTS

- Whenever Brad appears, or is introduced in some way the line "Arsehole!" is appropriate.
- When Janet is introduced or appears, the line "Slut!" is appropriate.
- Whenever the Narrator appears, call: "He's got no neck!"
- Dr. Scott may be booed or called "Kiss Arse!".
- We also encourage you to sing-along to the songs if you know the words!



ACTIONS

- At the beginning of the film is the wedding of Ralph Hapschatt and Betty Munroe. As the newlyweds exit the church, throw confetti along with the on-screen wedding guests.
- When Brad and Janet get stuck in the rain, cover your head with a Newspaper like Janet, or if you are one of the lucky guests to be given a water pistol squirt it to simulate the rainstorm.
- Let's Do the Time Warp! Put on your party hat and get up and dance along! Don't worry if you don't know the moves, the song will tell you what to do.
- During and after the creation speech, Dr. Frank-N-Furt snaps his rubber gloves three times. Later, Magenta pulls these gloves off his hands. You should snap your gloves in sync each time to create a fantastic sound effect.
- At the dinner table, when Frank puts on a party hat, you should do the same.
